BIBLE BLAST

Todays lesson is all about the calling of the first Disciples.

It is found in *Matthew 4:18-22*. *Read the* passage together – choose a Bible translation or children's story version which best suits your family.

This passage tells the story of how Jesus called his first disciples – Peter, Andrew, James and John. Two sets of brothers; these men were fishermen on the sea of Galilee.

When walking along the shore, Jesus spotted
Peter & Andrew fishing and called them to follow Him, and He would make them fishers of men.
They immediately left their boats behind and the same thing happened with James & John.

As disciples of Jesus, it is our call to follow
Him as these men did – with all our hearts and
our lives. Fishing for men is obviously different
to fishing for fish, but as we follow Jesus it is
o() our role to draw people closer to

Him by our actions, our words and our faith.

PRAYER FEET!


Let everyone show their feet! (shoes on, Shoes off, in sock soles, bare feet!)

Remind them that God has a journey planned for us, and the journey of following Jesus is a great adventure!
Somewhere where our feet will take us!

Ask the children to think about when it is difficult to follow Jesus, and ask God for His help and encouragement.

Jesus, thank you for your love for us.
Help us to follow you.
Help us to show others how to
follow you too. Amen.

Play a game called "Follow The Leader".





Let them show the actions and everyone else must follow.

When they say, "Do this" they must put an action to it, e.g. hands up in the air (everyone must follow).

Keep doing this until they say, "Do that" and show an action BUT this time no one must follow the action, otherwise they are out!!

Let others be the leader and "Follow The Leader".

Some of you will know that people follow famous people on Instagram or Snapchat. People like singers and actors often have millions of followers.

When we followed the leader we copied their actions, that's what following Jesus means TO BE LIKE JESUS.

Our story today is about following . . . following Jesus.

Jesus was in a town by the sea of Galilee. The sea of Galilee was full of lots of lovely fish, so what jobs do you

think the people had who worked there?
Fishermen! As He was walking by, He spotted
two fishermen brothers working on their boat –
their names were Peter and Andrew. They were
throwing a net into the water to catch some
fish. Jesus called out to them saying – "Come,
and follow me – and I will teach you how to fish
for people!"

What a strange thing to say! How can you fish for people?

Age 5-7

How can we follow Jesus? Can we really fish for men? What does that mean? Is it easy to follow Jesus? Or is it hard?



Age 8-10

How can you follow Jesus in your life? What does it mean to fish men? What things are easy/hard about following Jesus? How/when/where can we tell others about Jesus?

The strangest thing of all was that Peter and Andrew did just as He said! They left their boats and followed Him! And as they walked up the shore together, they met two other brothers, James and John – and the same thing happened!

They became the first followers of Jesus. Disciples! And now many years later Jesus asks us to follow Him too. It means loving others the way Jesus loved others. It means loving the people around us and the people we don't like. It means looking after the sick and the poor.



FISHING ROD You will need: fish, rod - can be a pencil, scissors, colouring pencils/felt-tips, string/wool/ribbon, hole punch, decorating materials.

- 1. Cut out and decorate the fish template or they might want to draw their own design of fish!
- 2. Let the children know that they are fishing for men/woman/friends/family etc and write the name of someone they know, whom they would love to know Jesus, onto each fish.
- 3. Hole punch the fish at the mouth end and tie string through, attach to rod.



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
