Junior Section Rules

- Respect your officers and other boys at all times. Remember that officers provide their time on a voluntary basis and have many other commitments outside of the BB.
- No mobile phones are permitted except in circumstances where officer consent has been obtained in advance.
 There will always be a phone available for boys to use on parade nights.
- It is expected that all boys will support all activities and events organised at Company and Battalion level i.e. Church parades, sports and inter company Competitions. *
- Discipline policy will be in force at all times.
- Boys must be in full uniform and ready for inspection by 6.30pm on normal parade nights.
- Permission must be obtained from an officer to leave the hall, go to the toilet.
- No talking is permitted during opening / closing inspection or when any officer is speaking.
- Boys must stay in their squads and not be disruptive during inspection.
- Any questions about the instructions given can be asked **after** the officer finishes speaking.
- Boys must bring a PE kit each week and change for sport only when the officer concerned has told them to.
- Leaders are happy to listen so please tell them if you are unwell or unhappy.
- Please listen carefully to all announcements at the end of the evening.

As with all organisations a set of rules is a must, however they are only there to be enforced when the necessity arises.



*It is recognised that boys will not be able to attend all events, as they will have other commitments e.g. school events etc, but attendance at Church parades is essential, as these will count towards end of year marks and some of their achievements. If a boy cannot be present a parent or guardian should inform an officer.

Covid-19 Privacy Notice

We have added a temporary Privacy Notice for collecting contact information in relation to attending face-to-face BB activities during the current Covid-19 outbreak. This privacy notice is an addendum to The Boys' Brigades main privacy notice and data protection policy.

We are collecting your name and contact details in order to fulfil our responsibility to comply with Government requirements for 'Track and Trace' (or equivalent in England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales). We will only use this information to contact you in the event that we believe you may have come into contact with a suspected case of COVID-19 through BB activities and it may be necessary to share your details with NHS Track and Trace (or equivalent body) if they are requested for contact tracing and the investigation of local outbreaks. Your name and contact details will be securely stored. They will be retained for this purpose for a period of 21 days in line with government guidance.

Please inform your local Boys' Brigade group as soon as possible if you test positive for Coronavirus or develop any of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Data Protection legislation allows us to process this information as we regard it as being in The Boys' Brigades legitimate interest. The Information Commissioner's Office has published guidance on data handling during the pandemic.
